



2020 Rosé



The organically farmed Pinot Noir and Zinfandel grapes for this 2020 rosé were hand picked from our family's home ranch, Redwood Valley Vineyards, in Mendocino County. After destemming, the grapes were immediately transferred to press where we gently extracted for juice and color. The wine was then cold settled and clarified for 48 hours and then separated from the lees prior to yeast inoculation. A slow fermentation at 50-55F promoted the fresh fruit aromas and crisp flavors. The journey from juice to wine lasted 22 days. Cold aged at 32F for 95 days to retain freshness and fruit character.

Pale pink in color, with aromas of fresh strawberries, rose petals and passion fruit. On the palate, this wine is crisp and clean, with refreshing acidity. Subtle flavors of strawberry, raspberry, white peach, and citrus. Delicately fruity, this blend of Pinot Noir and Zinfandel delivers a bright, balanced wine that will appeal to a wide range of rosé lovers.
